- I. Call to Order
 - A. Tim called meeting to order at 12:02pm
- II. New Business
 - A. Refinancing Authorization
 - Tim asked if refinance was a 30-year term. Brittnee said no, Hamlin only offers shorter term loans.
 - Tim asked whether Moody's rating matters in this scenario. Brittnee said Moody's rating may be used though it won't really make a difference on refinancing.
